1. Fully open the driver's window.



2. Install bracket B to the door sash at the measurement shown. Verify the shape at the identification mark stamped on the bracket. Be sure the door run channel is installed properly before installing the bracket.

3. Install bracket C on the door sash at the measurement shown. Verify the shape and the identification mark stamped on the bracket. Be sure the door run channel is installed properly before installing the bracket.



4. Peel back approximately 1-1/2 to 2 inches of adhesive backing from each adhesive tape, and tape the ends to the front surface of the left front door visor.



5. Using isopropyl alcohol on a shop towel, clean the door sash where the left front door visor will attach.



6. Position the door visor on the door sash.

7. Adjust the position of bracket B to install the door visor, then install a clip. Push up on bracket B so the tip of the door run channel fits tightly to the bracket. There should be no clearance between the bracket and the door sash.



- 8. Adjust the position of bracket C to install the door visor, then install the clip. Push up on bracket C so the door run channel fit tightly to the bracket. There should be no clearance between the bracket and the door sash.
- 9. Measure the distance between the edge of the door visor and the outside edge of the door sash as shown.





10. Fully open the left rear door glass.



11. Install bracket B to the door sash at the measurement shown. Verify the shape and the identification mark stamped on the bracket. Be sure the door run channel is installed properly before installing the bracket.

12. Install the bracket C to the door sash at the measurement shown. Verify the shape and the identification mark stamped on the bracket. Be sure the door run channel is installed properly before installing the bracket.



13. Peel back approximately 1-1/2 to 2 inches of adhesive backing from each adhesive tape, and tape the ends to the front surface of the left rear door visor.



14. Using isopropyl alcohol on a shop towel, clean the door sash where the door visor will attach.



15. Position the door visor on the door sash.

16. Adjust the position of bracket B to align with the door visor then install a clip. Push up on bracket B so the lip of the run channel fits tightly to the bracket. There should be no clearance between the bracket and the door sash.



17. Adjust the position of bracket C to align with the door visor, then install a clip. Push up on bracket C so the lip of the run channel fits tightly to the bracket. There should be no clearance between the bracket and the door sash.



 Measure the distance between the edge of the door visor and the outside edge of the door sash as shown.



- 19. Press the left front door visor firmly against the driver's door. Starting from the rear edge of the door visor and working forward, remove the two adhesive backings:
 - Attach the adhesive backing on the door visor to the door sash while pushing up the brackets with your finger so that there is no clearance between the bracket and the door sash.
 - Use a soft towel when pressing on the door visor.



- 20. Press the left rear door visor firmly against the left rear door. Starting from the rear edge of the door visor and working forward, remove the two adhesive backings.
 - Attach the adhesive backing on the door visor to the door sash while pushing up the brackets by your finger so that there is no clearance between the bracket and door sash.
 - Use a soft towel when pressing on the door visor.
- 21. Repeat steps 1 through 20 to install the door visors on the right side of the vehicle.



USE AND CARE

Clean the door visors with mild detergent and water. Do not use organic solvents (thinner, benzine, alcohol, etc.) or cleaners containing any abrasive material.
