


## With Fog Lights


If the vehicle is equipped with fog lights, cut out the piece of the nose mask that covers the fog lights:

- Face the inside of the mask toward you.
- Carefully cut out the overcast stitching with a utility knife. Remove the stitching and the fog light cover.
- Repeat the same procedure on the other side.




## Installing the Nose Mask

1. Turn the steering wheel fully clockwise.




- 2. Remove and discard the clip from the driver's front inner fender.
- 3. Install one fenderwell nut into the driver's front fender.
- 4. Place a washer on a snap-screw, and install the snap-screw into the fenderwell nut.
- 5. Turn the steering wheel fully counterclockwise, and repeat steps 2 thru 4 to install a snap-screw to the right fender.

6. Pull the mask back toward the driver's front inner fender, smooth out any wrinkles, and secure the snap on the nose mask to the snap-screw.




- 7. Secure the three hooks on the nose mask to the driver's fenderwell.
- 8. Repeat steps 6 and 7 on the right side of the vehicle.
- 9. Open the hood. Insert the seven tabs on the nose mask between the driver's headlight and the bumper.



NOSE MASK


10. Repeat the same procedure on the right side of the vehicle.

11. Secure the six hooks on the nose mask to the vehicle frame as shown.




NOSE MASK

12. Secure the four hooks on the nose mask to the bottom of the vehicle as shown.




13. Route the elastic cord through the 14 loops on the bottom of the nose mask.



- 14. Secure one hook on the elastic cord to the bottom of the vehicle as shown.
- 15. Stretch out the elastic cord after routing it through each loop, then secure the hook to the vehicle.

16. Secure the eight hooks on the nose mask to the front grille as shown.





17. Close the hood, and adjust the position of the nose mask to the hood.

## **CLEANING THE NOSE MASK**

Use a sponge or cloth with a solution of mild liquid dishwashing soap and water to clean the vinyl and the flannel backing. Rinse the mask completely with a clean water, and hang it to dry out in direct sunlight. Make sure the mask is completely dry before you reinstall it.
