

Illustration of the Trailer Hitch on the Vehicle




INSTALLATION

Customer Information: The information in this installation instruction is intended for use only by skilled technicians who have the proper tools, equipment, and training to correctly and safely add equipment to your vehicle. These procedures should not be attempted by "do-it-yourselfers."

1. Remove the cargo lid.




2. Remove the spare tire plug cap.



3. Remove the spare tire plug to access the spare tire hoist shaft. Lower the spare tire completely.




4. Remove the rear bumper lower face.



5. Remove the two clip nuts from the rear bumper lower face, and install them on the trailer hitch cover.




6. Install the trailer hitch cover to the rear bumper with six retaining tabs, two clips, two self-tapping screws, and two bolts removed in step 4.



7. Loosely secure the trailer hitch to the vehicle with six flange bolts, then tighten the six flange bolts. Torque the six flange bolts to 95 N·m (70 lb·ft)


NOTE: Have an assistant help you when installing the trailer hitch.




8. Install all removed parts.

Whenever you remove the hitch pin, and the ball mount, store them securely in the cargo area. Then, install the receiver cover into the opening at the end of the trailer hitch.



Install the ball mount into the trailer hitch using a hitch pin clip and hitch pin. And store the receiver cover in the cargo area



After the first 600 miles (1,000 km) of towing, have your Honda Dealer re-check the tightness of the trailer hitch bolts.
