



INSTALLATION


NOTE:

- These instructions show the right speaker being installed. The same procedure applies to installing the left speaker.
- · Be careful not to damage the linings.


- 1. Using scissors, cut out the template as indicated.
- Slide the passenger's seat all the way forward, and tilt the seat-back forward. Position the template on the bulkhead carpet in the area shown, then mark the edge of the hole in the template on the carpet with a felt-tip pen. Remove the template.




Cut out the marked area from the carpet with a utility knife and scissors as described.




- 4. Remove the speaker hole cover, and disconnect the 2-pin connector secured to the back of the cover. Pull the 2-pin connector out of the speaker hole as shown. Discard the cover.
- Cut an EPT sealer into halves, then wrap one half of the EPT sealer around the right vehicle speaker harness at a point about 10 mm away from the connector as indicated.




- 6. Inside the right speaker hole, attach the other half of the EPT sealer to the bracket for the duct as shown.
- 7. Push a screw grommet from the kit into each of the three square holes in the edge of the speaker opening.



8. Position the speaker trim over the speaker opening, and align the holes. Plug the vehicle speaker harness 2-pin connector into the terminals on the speaker, then position the speaker on the speaker trim. Install and tighten the three self-tapping screws securely.



9. Install the speaker cover.



- 10. Repeat steps 2 through 4, and 7 through 9 to install the speaker on the driver's side.
- 11. Check that all wire harnesses are routed properly and all connectors are plugged in.
- 12. Turn on the radio, and check the rear speakers for proper operation.
