MOONROOF VISOR 5. Attach a short strip of masking tape to both sides of the vehicle's roof ahead of the point where the clips will attach to the moonroof opening. Remove the visor.



6. Using isopropyl alcohol on a shop towel, clean each corner where the protective tapes will attach; then remove the adhesive backing from one of the protective tapes, and attach the tape to the lip and underside of the moonroof opening, in line with the masking tape. Be sure the tape just touches the *inner* lip on the underside of the moonroof opening. Remove the masking tape.



7. Repeat step 6 on the other side at the point where you applied the masking tape.

8. Reposition the moonroof visor over the moonroof opening. Check again for equal spacing. While holding the moonroof visor in place, hook the clips **between** the *inner* lip and the *outer* lip of the moonroof opening at the taped locations.



- 9. Check that the rubber seal is not twisted or rolled under the moonroof visor.
- 10. Tighten the nuts and screws, alternating between sides. Do not overtighten the screws.

CARE OF YOUR MOONROOF VISOR

NOTICE To avoid damaging the surface, never use ammonia-based cleaners or solvents to clean your moonroof visor.

- 1. Clean with a solution of mild liquid dishwashing soap and water using a soft cloth or chamois.
- 2. To remove fine scratches and restore the original luster, use Meguiar's Mirror Glaze plastic cleaner and polish, or an equivalent high-quality plastic cleaner.
