



Front roof rack




Rear roof rack



4 End covers





TOOLS REQUIRED


- Flat-tip screwdriver
- 5 mm Hex wrench
- Isopropyl alcohol
- Shop towel
- T-25 Torx wrench

INSTALLATION


Customer Information: The information in this installation instruction is intended for use only by skilled technicians who have the proper tools, equipment, and training to correctly and safely add equipment to your vehicle. These procedures should not be attempted by "do-it-yourselfers."

NOTE: Be careful not to damage the roof and other finished surfaces of the body when installing the roof rack.

- Using a flat-tip screwdriver wrapped with a shop towel, remove the two front covers and the two rear covers from the roof trim.




2. Clean the rubber seal attachment position with a shop towel moistened with isopropyl alcohol.
3. Remove the adhesive backing from the rubber seal, and attach the rubber seal to the inside of the roof trim as shown.
 - When attaching the rubber seal, align the center of the rubber seal with the hole at the center of the roof rack installation base as shown.
 - Attach the rubber seal with the ends aligned at the beginning of the curvature as shown.




4. Attach the rubber seals to the remaining three locations in the same manner.


5. Position the front and rear roof racks on the roof in the proper locations as shown.



6. If the ends of the right and left roof racks are not aligned, adjust them by loosening the crossbar socket bolts, and moving the stays in or out as necessary.



7. Install the roof racks with 12 socket bolts and 12 washers. Do not tighten.



8. Tighten the crossbar socket bolts (if loosened in step 6). Torque the 12 roof rack mounting socket bolts to 9-10 N·m (6-7 lb·ft)
9. Install the four end covers.
10. Place the covers (removed in step 1) in the glove box for your customer to reinstall when the roof rack is removed.
