Installing the Front Upper Molding

1. Measure and mark the left front door, and attach masking tape in the area shown.



 On the inside of the left front upper molding, attach a strip of masking tape to the ends of the long adhesive backing and peel back 1-1/2 to 2 in. (3-5 cm) of the adhesive backing. Tape the ends to the front of the moldings. Remove and discard all other adhesive backings.



- 3. Using an alcohol pad, clean the door where the left front upper molding will attach.
- 4. Align the front and the rear end of the left front upper molding with the masking tapes. Attach the rear edge of the molding to the edge of the door. Continue holding the molding in alignment, and carefully pull out the adhesive backing from under each side; then press the molding into place.



5. Using a hard rubber roller, apply pressure against the molding, and roll from one end to the other.



Installing the Front Lower Molding

6. Measure and mark the left front door, and attach masking tape in the area shown.



 On the inside of the left front lower molding, attach a strip of masking tape to the ends of the long adhesive backing and peel back 1-1/2 to 2 in. (3-5 cm) of the adhesive backing. Tape the ends to the front of the moldings. Remove and discard all other adhesive backings.
