

INSTALLATION


Customer Information: The information in this installation instruction is intended for use only by skilled technicians who have the proper tools, equipment, and training to correctly and safely add equipment to your vehicle. These procedures should not be attempted by "do-it-yourselfers."

NOTE:

- · Be careful not to damage the paint finish.
- These instructions show the left splash guards being installed. The same procedure applies to installing the right splash guards.
- Clean and wax the areas to be covered with a highquality paste wax.


Installing the Front Splash Guards

1. Turn the steering wheel fully counterclockwise.



2. Using a pushpin, pierce the centers of the three clips shown on the left front inner fender.


3. Secure the left front splash guard with three 5 x 25 mm self-tapping screws in the order shown below. NOTE: Make sure there is no gap between the left front splash guard and the vehicle body. If there is a gap, loosen the self-tapping screws, hold the splash guard against the body, and retighten the screws.




4. Turn the steering wheel fully clockwise, and repeat steps 2 and 3 to install the right front splash guard on the right side of the vehicle.

Installing the Left Rear Splash Guard


5. Remove four self-tapping screws from the rear bumper and the left rear inner fender.




6. Working inside the fenderwell, use a small flat-tip screwdriver to release the tabs on the clip, then remove the clip with a trim tool.




7. Remove the fender cover (one drain tube clip).




8. Install one grommet A into the hole in the fenderwell.



9. Pull the rear bumper away from the body, and release the seven retaining tabs.




10. Install one grommet B into the hole in the fenderwell.




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11. Reinstall the rear bumper onto the retaining tabs, and reinstall one self-tapping screw.




- 12. Install one spring nut over the hole in the rear bumper. Make sure to install the spring nut in the correct position and orientation.
- 13. Attach the left rear splash guard on the inner side of the left rear inner fender, and install the drain tube clip to the left rear splash guard.




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14. Secure the left rear splash guard with two 5 x 25 mm self-tapping screws and one 5 x 30 mm self-tapping screw in the order shown below.

NOTE: Make sure there is no gap between the left rear splash guard and the bumper. If there is a gap, loosen the self-tapping screws, hold the splash guard against the bumper, and retighten the screws.




15. Secure the left rear splash guard with one clip.




Installing the Right Rear Splash Guard


16. Remove four self-tapping screws from the rear bumper and the right rear inner fender.



17. Working inside the fenderwell, use a small flat-tip screwdriver to release the tabs on the clip, then remove the clip with a trim tool. Remove the fender cover.




18. Install one grommet A into the hole in the fenderwell.




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19. Pull the rear bumper away from the body, and release the seven retaining tabs.




20. Install one grommet B into the hole in the fenderwell.



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
21. Reinstall the rear bumper onto the retaining tabs, and reinstall one self-tapping screw.



22. Install one spring nut over the hole in the rear bumper. Make sure to install the spring nut in the correct position and orientation.

23. Attach the right rear splash guard on the inner side of the right rear inner fender, and secure the right rear splash guard with two 5 x 25 mm self-tapping screws and one 5 x 30 mm self-tapping screw in the order shown below.

NOTE: Make sure there is no gap between the right rear splash guard and the bumper. If there is a gap, loosen the self-tapping screws, hold the splash guard against the bumper, and retighten the screws.



24. Secure the right rear splash guard with one clip.
